CHALLENGE ONE

Battle Creek PD had to force their information into forms that didn’t fit their needs, which sometimes meant leaving out details on long use of force reports.

OUTCOME

Easy-to-configure forms

Battle Creek easily configured forms (like use of force, pursuits, and others) to fit their unique language and processes – no missing details.

Officers had to enter data from the same incident multiple times on different reports, taking up valuable time and causing data entry errors.
