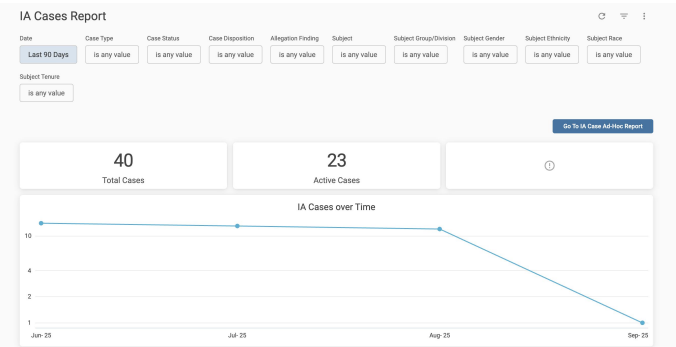


CHALLENGE ONE

Manual data entry slowed reporting and tied up staff hours. Use of force statistics had to be compiled by hand, and supervisors often lacked timely insight into how cases were progressing.

✓ OUTCOME

Automated reporting eliminated manual data entry, saving staff hours each week and producing instant statistics. Supervisors have real-time visibility into cases, reviews stay on track, and staff can focus on core responsibilities instead of admin work.



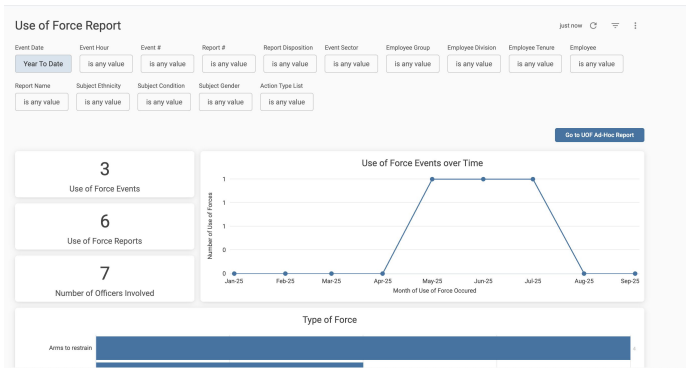
Example IA cases report dashboard

CHALLENGE TWO

Paper-heavy processes made disclosures and audits cumbersome. Records were scattered across binders and spreadsheets, creating extra costs and slowing preparation.

✓ OUTCOME

Centralized, paperless workflows simplify disclosure prep and reduce storage needs. Records are secure, easy to access, and the agency is realizing long-term time and cost savings.
