Evaluate your agency's ability to proactively support first responder wellness, recognize early warning signs, and identify burnout before it starts.

- Support often starts after an incident rather than before.
- Families have limited access to resources that support responder wellbeing.
- Early intervention is sometimes seen as punitive and not genuine support.

0–2: Solid Start

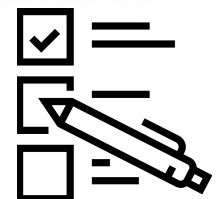
You're building proactive systems and culture. Integrations could make your wellness program more connected and measurable.
