I. POLICY:

It is the policy of the Georgia Department of Corrections that before an opposite sex staff member or visitor enters an area where inmates may be undressed, that he or she will be announced and inmates allowed to robe.

II. APPLICABILITY:

All incarcerate facilities housing GDC inmates or probationers.

VI. PROCEDURE:

- A. Before an opposite sex staff member or visitor enters an area where inmates may be undressed, he or she will request that the correctional officer in charge announce that he or she will be entering the area.
- B. Inmates will be allowed an appropriate amount of time to dress before the opposite sex staff member or visitor enters the area.
- C. In the case of seclusion or restraint, inmates will be allowed to remain dressed unless contra-indicated.
