

- A. **PURPOSE.** To provide a safe and healthy work environment for our employees by eliminating or minimizing occupational exposure to bloodborne pathogens, in accordance with MIOSHA rules 325.0001-.700018.
- B. **GRAND RAPIDS POLICE DEPARTMENT EXPOSURE CONTROL PLAN**
1. This plan is a key document to assist in implementing and ensuring compliance with the standard, thereby protecting our employees from bloodborne diseases such as Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV), Hepatitis B Virus (HBV), Hepatitis C Virus (HCV) and sexually transmitted diseases.
 2. The Exposure Control Plan (ECP) and specific instructions on handling exposure incidents are frequently reviewed and revised. The Exposure Control Plan and exposure incident instructions are accessible to all employees at the following locations:
