# D6 and Court Financial Suspensions

**ANY service, including general information, provided by our Driver License Office is subject to \$6.25 at the beginning of the visit. Additional transaction fees may apply.**

**Not a Manatee County resident?** Out-of-County residents can only be served at our [Driver License Office](#), located at 904 301 Blvd W, Bradenton. An appointment is required. Visit [taxcollector.com](http://taxcollector.com) to schedule an appointment. You must select the “Non-Manatee County Resident DL/ID Card Transaction” Service in order to be served. Testing services (e.g. road testing, written exams) are provided for Manatee County residents only.

**Driver license information will not be provided over the telephone by the Manatee County Tax Collector’s Office.**

## How do I clear a traffic citation related suspension?

- Failure to comply with traffic summons/ticket?
- Failure to comply to appear on a traffic summons?
- Failure to pay a traffic fine?
- Failure to complete court-ordered school?
- School election was made when paying a ticket but failed to attend?
- School election was made but not eligible to attend?

Your driver license privilege is suspended indefinitely until the court requirements are met and your license is reinstated.

- Contact the [clerk of court](#) in the county where the ticket was issued to pay your fine. Some courts allow payments online or by phone. Obtain a certified clearance form. *Some courts have the ability to clear your driver license at the time you satisfy the court. Inquire with the court at the time you are paying your fine this will save you a trip to our office.*

**Please note:** Most counties in Florida are required to submit D6 clearances electronically, directly to the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (paper clearance forms will not be accepted from these counties). Please verify which option is required for your clearance with the County Clerk of Court where you received the traffic ticket.

- If the court has not cleared your license suspension, visit our Driver License Office at 904 301 Blvd W, Bradenton, to submit the clearance form and pay the [D6 suspension reinstatement fee](#) of \$66.25 and any other applicable reinstatement fees.
- If you did not obtain a clearance form or it was cleared electronically, you may check the status of your driver license at <https://services.flhsmv.gov/DLCheck/> to verify if the court has marked your record “court requirements met”. Checking the status of your driver license to ensure your record reflects this will save an extra trip to our office.
- Each visit to our office for information and/or reinstatements will be charged a \$6.25 Tax Collector fee along with any other applicable fees including but not limited to multiple sanction fees, multiple reinstatement fees, not having the required documents, replacement fee or renewal fee. Customers visiting our Driver License Office may experience long wait times. Customers are urged to make an appointment. Customers with appointments are given priority and are served before those that visit our office without one. If you are visiting our office for information or you have your required documents to clear and reinstate your driver license, visit [taxcollector.com](http://taxcollector.com) to schedule an appointment.

# D6 and Court Financial Suspensions

## How do I clear a suspension for failure to pay court financial obligations?

If your driver license is suspended for failing to pay court financial obligations, your driver license privilege is suspended indefinitely until the court requirements are met and your license is reinstated.

- Contact the [clerk of court](#) to which you owe financial obligations. Clearance for this suspension may be submitted electronically by the court or an Affidavit(s) from the court(s) within the last 30 days that contains specific requirements completed by the court.
- Affidavit(s) from the court(s) with the requirements used to reinstate your driver license must be originals and will not be returned.
- Reinstatements are completed by visiting our Driver License Office at 904 301 Blvd W, Bradenton, with the reinstatement fee of \$66.25 per sanction.
- Each visit to our office for information and/or reinstatements will be charged a \$6.25 Tax Collector fee along with any other applicable fees including but not limited to multiple sanction fees, multiple reinstatement fees, not having the required documents, replacement fee or renewal fee. Customers visiting our Driver License Office may experience long wait times. Customers are urged to make an appointment. Customers with appointments are given priority and are served before those that visit our office without one. If you are visiting our office for information or you have your required documents to clear and reinstate your driver license, visit [taxcollector.com](http://taxcollector.com) to schedule an appointment.

## Will receiving a traffic ticket in another state affect my Florida driver license record?

If you hold a Florida driver license and have received a ticket in another state, they will submit the ticket information to Florida's Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to be added to your Florida record. You will receive points on your driver license if the ticket is a point-accessible violation according to Florida Statute [322.27\(3\)](#). Florida law does not allow any school or program to remove points for a ticket received in another state. Visit <https://services.flhsmv.gov/DLCheck/> to check the status of your license.

Any unpaid ticket reported by another state will result in the suspension of your Florida driver license. You must contact the county/state where you received the ticket and obtain a clearance receipt with a Court seal and must include the applicable citation/ticket number. All 50 states and Washington, DC have various websites for consumers. Go to [other states links](#).

There will be a [D6 suspension reinstatement fee](#) due if the ticket was paid after the Florida suspension date. If you are not sure if you owe the reinstatement fee, have trouble contacting the county/state where you received the ticket, or if a ticket is listed incorrectly on your Florida driving record, please contact the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles at 850.617.2000.
