ID CARDS ISSUED FOR VOTER REGISTRATION PURPOSES

POLICY:

AUTHORITY

R.S. 40:1321 (C)

DEFINITION

The department is authorized to issue, free of charge, an identification card for voter registration purposes to those individuals who do not possess a valid Louisiana driver's license.

REQUIREMENTS

- The applicant must meet ALL current OMV identification requirements.
- The applicant must present (at the time of application) his voter registration card or certificate.
- The applicant must complete the Voter Affirmation Form ([DPSMV2035](#)).

Louisiana law does not provide for a duplicate ID card to be issued free of charge. Therefore, duplicates will be processed in the normal fashion with the appropriate fees.

If the applicant receives a mail-in renewal invitation and opts to renew by mail/IVR/internet, the transaction will be processed with the appropriate fees due. If the applicant brings the mail-in renewal invitation into the field office, along with his/her voter registration certificate, the above mentioned procedures will be followed and the transaction will be processed at no charge.

NOTE: In order to comply with the Military Selective Service Act (Act 373 of 2003 Regular Legislative Session - R.S. 32:40:1321(D)(1)), proof of social security is required by all male US citizens or immigrants age 15 to 26 who apply for a license or ID card. Failure to provide proof of social security number will result in a denial of issuance.
