**General:**

- All applicants eligible for a social security number must provide the assigned number when applying for a driver's license. Any alien individual who resides in Louisiana and who does not possess and is not eligible to obtain a social security number shall be required to furnish a letter from the Social Security Administration stipulating he is "ineligible" or that he "has not been issued" a social security number for a Class D or E driver's license.
- The Social Security Number is required from all US male citizens or immigrants age 15 to 26 who apply for a driver's license or ID card in accordance with the Military Selective Service Act, Failure to provide the SSN will result in the denial of issuance.
