Purpose: Any applicant needing accommodation due to a medical reason including any mental, physical or developmental disability shall be issued a driver's license and/or identification card, upon request, which shall display a "needs accommodation" indicator.

Requirements: A Medical Examiner's Certification of Need Accommodation Form [DPSMV2014](#) completed by a qualified medical professional licensed in Louisiana or any other state or territory of the United States.

General:

- The applicant cannot be a sex offender who is required to be registered under Chapter 3-B of Title 15.
- The driver's license and/or identification card cannot include either the "Veteran" or "I'm a Cajun" indicator.

Fees:

- No additional fee to add indicator.
